

# LOST CREEK CANYON RANCH

## Visitor Rules

Welcome to Lost Creek Canyon Ranch. We are a 400 acre, working ranch located on a preserve with livestock, wildlife, uneven terrain, and ranch equipment. For the safety of our guests, animals, property, and the environmentally sensitive land, all visitors must follow the rules below.

### **Ranch Rules**

- 1. No Smoking**  
Smoking is not allowed anywhere on the ranch.
- 2. No Open Fires**  
Open fires are prohibited. Visitors may not bring matches or lighters onto the ranch.
- 3. No Pets**  
Due to having eight working Livestock Guardian Dogs protecting our animals and ranch, pets **not allowed** on the ranch. Visitors arriving with animals will not be permitted to enter.
- 4. Liability Waiver Required**  
All visitors must sign a Release of Liability Form before entering the ranch.
- 5. Proper Clothing Required**  
Visitors must wear long pants and closed-toe shoes.  
Boots or shoes with good traction are strongly recommended due to uneven terrain and hills.  
Weather can be unpredictable and always at least 10 degrees cooler than Palm Springs. We suggest bringing a jacket or sweater, a hat, and sunglasses.
- 6. Speed Limit**  
All vehicles must drive under 15 mph on ranch roads.
- 7. Livestock Safety**  
Do not feed livestock without permission from ranch managers or owners.  
Close and secure all livestock gates behind you.
- 8. Service Dogs**  
Service dogs are allowed only under the following conditions:  
Professionally trained and non-reactive to livestock, guardian dogs, pets, and people  
Proof of current vaccinations must be provided  
Dog and owner must wait outside the gate for proper introduction to ranch dogs before entering
- 9. Children**  
This is a rural working ranch environment and may not be suitable for young children.  
Parents of visitors under 18 years must receive permission from the ranch owners before entering.
